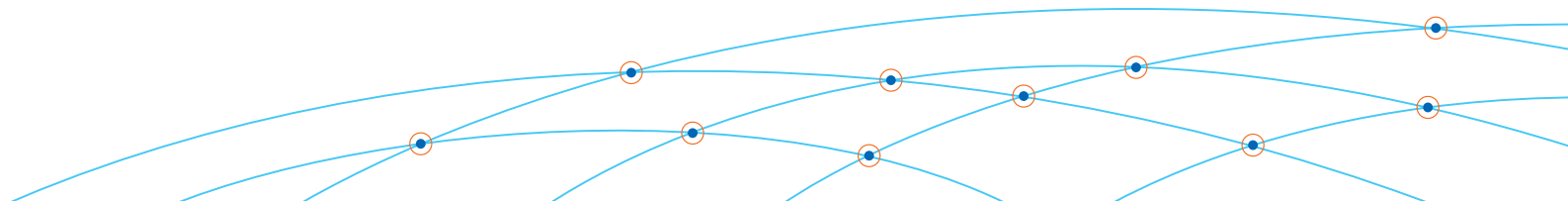

The tragic events of September 11 destroyed two landmark buildings in New York known as the World Trade Center or the Twin Towers. However, not many people are aware that there are World Trade Centers in 300 cities around the world, operating with the support and under the umbrella of the World Trade Centers Association (WTCA).

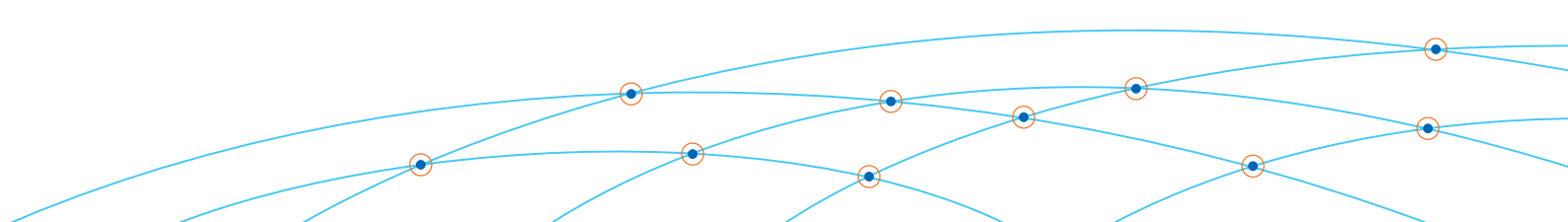
With headquarters in New York, the WTCA was established to facilitate international trade by bringing together exporters, importers and service providers. The first seeds of the international movement were shown in 1970 when the pioneer World Trade Centers - Houston, New Orleans, New York and Tokyo - and a number of World Trade Center enthusiasts first organised the World Trade Centers Association.

Today, the WTCA is a non-political, not-for-profit association dedicated to the establishment and effective operation of World Trade Centers as instruments for trade expansion. Among other things it also develops and offers inter-WTC cooperative programmes.

WTCA membership includes some 300 WTCs in 90 countries. Over 750,000 companies are affiliated with WTCA members worldwide. Indeed, the WTCA ranks as a world leader in offering innovative services for international business.

The WTCA's founding principles are as applicable today as they were 35 years ago:

- To encourage the expansion of world trade;
- To promote international business relationships and understanding among nations;
- To foster increased participation in world trade by industrialising nations;

The WTCA is governed by an international Board of Directors, composed of executives from WTCA members around the world, and elected by the membership. Eight permanent committees have been established to carry out the work of the Association in the fields of:

- Public Relations and Information
- Tourism, Hospitality and Cultural Exchange
- Trade Education, Training and Research
- Trade Fairs, Trade Marts and High Tech Parks
- WTC Standards and Quality

A World Trade Center is a one-stop trade information hub that brings together businesses and government agencies involved in foreign trade, and puts all the services associated with global commerce under one roof.

Each local WTC is unique in the area it operates in and offers a portfolio of services and facilities to members and non-members alike. Since WTC services are reciprocal, members can access them at all operating WTCs around the world. Offering local support to companies seeking to expand their activities to international markets, WTCs typically offer the following services and facilities:

- **WTCA OnLine (www.wtca.org)**
An online forum which allows members to post and review trade opportunities, leads, access valuable databases and communicate with new business prospects.
- **Trade Information & Market Research**
Information on local products and services, market conditions, government regulations, as well as market surveys, and profiles of business contacts.
- **Trade Education**
Through regular speaker programmes, interactive discussions, seminars and workshops on important local and global business issues.
- **Business Services**
Including secretarial services, translation services, travel arrangements, temporary office space and meeting rooms.
- **Group Trade Missions**
WTCs help businesses explore new markets to promote their products and services through both inbound and outbound trade missions.
- **Trade Shows & Exhibition Space**
Supported by professional staff, WTCs offer facilities and the necessary support services for trade shows in every industrial and service sector.
- **WTC Clubs**
WTCs feature comfortable lounge and dining services for members and their guests.

As such, a World Trade Center is an internationally acknowledged and recognisable symbol of focused efforts to strengthen the local economy by supporting businesses interested in cross-border activities.

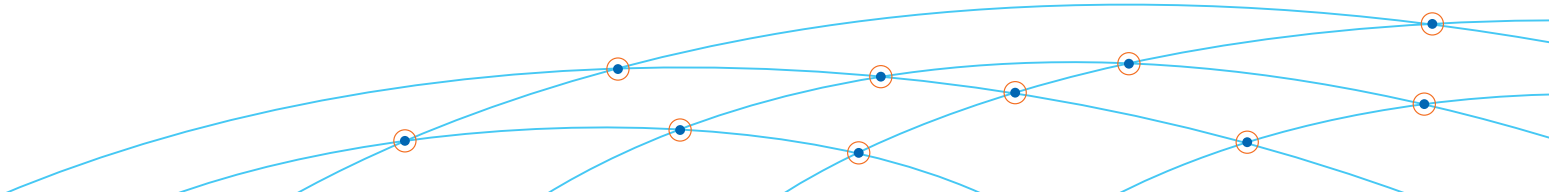
